#### contraception (n)

 the deliberate use of artificial methods or other techniques to prevent pregnancy as a consequence of sexual intercourse

## dental hygienist (n)

- a dental worker specializing in scaling and polishing teeth and giving advice on teeth cleaning detection (n)
- the action or process of identifying the presence of something concealed effectiveness (n)

#### related: effective (adj)

- the degree to which something is successful in producing a desired result; success immunization (n)
  - the action of making a person or animal resistant to a particular infectious disease or pathogen, typically by vaccination

## intervention (n)

- the act of coming between so as to prevent or alter a result or course of events
   power of attorney (n)
- the authority to act for another person in specified or all legal or financial matters
   prenatal (adj)
  - before birth; during or relating to pregnancy

## preventive / preventative (adj)

- designed to keep something undesirable such as illness, harm, or accidents from occurring reduction (n)
  - the action or fact of making a specified thing smaller or less in amount, degree, or size

# risk (n)

a situation involving exposure to danger

# screenings (n)

- the evaluation or investigation of something as part of a methodical survey side effect (n)
- a secondary, typically undesirable effect of a drug or medical treatment wellness (n)
  - the state of being in good health, especially as an actively pursued goal
