

16-WEEK COURSE

- i. Improve reading and writing skills for those with a high school diploma
- ii. Complete high school equivalency exam (GED/HiSET) if you don't have a high school diploma
- iii. Complete the required CPR class
- iv. Prepare for the college entrance exam and the BNA course content
- v. Attend the mandatory BNA
- vi. Receive assistance with job placement through WIOA

8-WEEK COURSE

- i. Complete the BNA course at Olive-Harvey College
- ii. Sit for the Certified Nursing Assistant Exam
- iii. Career Exploration in Healthcare Field
- iv. (3 days/week) lecture and simulation lab (1 day/week) clinical in a long-term facility or hospital setting

NEXT STEPS

- i. Work as a CNA in hospital, medical center, clinic, skilled nursing facility, etc.
- ii. Advance into programs such as Patient Care Tech EMT, Community Healthcare Worker, Management Support, Medical Billing and Coding, Medical Receptionist, and many more. You will need a CNA license to beain coursework for nursina.
