 - Sending a picture of one of the documents listed below to <<Generic Email>> OR
 - Showing the document to an Adult Education staff member in a video Zoom call at <<Virtual Student Services>>
 - Some acceptable documents include:
 - A valid driver's license or state ID
 - A valid passport (U.S. or Home Country)
 - Any other form of government-issued ID (Chicago, national or foreign)
 - If your ID does not include a current Illinois address, you may provide additional documentation using 1 of the following: bank statement, mortgage/deed/lease, insurance policy, official mail from a government agency, pay stub, utility bill, or Illinois temporary driver's license.
2. Complete the placement survey and schedule preference survey:
 - You will receive an email in the next 48 hours with a link to complete a short survey.
 - Please complete this survey on your own to the best of your ability.
 - This placement survey will be used to identify your class level for Fall classes.
3. Once you complete the survey and confirm you live in Illinois, you will be registered for a class/classes by the Adult Education staff.
 - Classes begin the week of August 24.
 - At the beginning of the semester, you will be contacted by your teacher with more information about the class.
