### TRAINING FOR TEST ADMINISTRATORS (Required)

**CASAS Implementation Training** is for those who administer paper or online CASAS tests: Reading GOALS, Math GOALS 2, CASAS Reading STEPS, or CASAS Listening STEPS. This training is required by ICCB for all individuals who give CASAS tests.

Goal: Participants learn to administer CASAS tests correctly to ensure validity and to maximize measurable skill gains.

### NEW! TRAINING FOR TEACHERS (Recommended)

**CASAS Tools for Teachers** is for instructors whose students take CASAS assessments: Reading GOALS, Math GOALS2, CASAS Reading STEPS, or CASAS Listening STEPS. Separate trainings are offered for ABE/ASE and English Language Acquisition (ELA) instructors.

Goal: Instructors learn to use the CASAS blueprints and CASAS test reports to plan effective, standards-based instruction and maximize measurable skill gains.
